# Digital Materials on Your Black and White Kindle

Includes the Kindle, Kindle Paperwhite, and Kindle Voyage

### **Overdrive: The Basics**

- Available material types:
  - E-books
- Check out limits:
  - 10 items
- Digital materials check out for 14 days and many can be returned early if needed
- You'll never receive late fines; digital materials automatically stop working at the end of the checkout period
- Most items can only be checked out to one person at a time so sometimes you'll need to place a hold

#### Instructions

#### Step 1: Log in to Overdrive

- Connect to <a href="http://virtuallibrary.overdrive.com">http://virtuallibrary.overdrive.com</a>
- Click Sign In
- Enter your library card number and PIN and click Sign In

#### Step 2: Search for e-books

- Search by title, author, or keyword using the search box at the top of your screen
- Browse by categories by clicking the menu button ( ≡ ) or Subjects and choosing a category

#### Step 3: Checkout an e-book

- Once you find an e-book, click the cover, then click **Borrow** 
  - If the button says *Place a Hold*, this item is checked out and can be placed on hold
- Click on Go To Loans
- Click on *Download* next to your e-book and select *Kindle Book*; this will open a new page that displays your book on Amazon.com

- Select the device you want the e-book delivered to and click *Get Library Book* 
  - o If prompted, type in your Amazon.com email address and password

To transfer your e-book wirelessly, proceed to step 4a. To transfer your e-book using a USB cable, proceed to step 4b.

- Step 4a. Transfer the e-book to your Kindle using a Wi-Fi connection
  - Turn on your Kindle and connect to a Wi-Fi connection; the e-book will then be transferred to your Kindle and appear on the Home screen
    - If you don't see your new e-book, go to your Kindle menu and choose Sync & Check for Items
- Step 4b. Transfer the e-book to your Kindle using a USB cable
  - On the next screen, click *Download now*; your book should now be downloaded into your *downloads* folder
    - o If prompted, click *Save*
  - Plug your Kindle into a USB port on your computer
  - Open your downloads folder and find your e-book file
  - Move your e-book file into the *documents* folder on your Kindle
  - Unplug your Kindle from the computer; the e-book should now appear on your Kindle Home screen

#### To return an e-book early:

- Go to Amazon.com on your computer and sign in to your account if you aren't already logged in
- Hover over the **Your Account** button and click on the **Your Content & Devices** option
  - o If prompted, type in your password
- Select the e-book you'd like to return or delete, click the Actions button and choose
  Return this book (if returning early) or Delete (if loan has expired)
